Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana (BSKY)

To protect economically vulnerable families from falling into this poverty trap by catastrophic health expenditure, Hon. Chief Minister, Odisha has launched universal Health Assurance scheme, Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana (BSKY) on 15th August 2018. It has two components.

I.1. Components:

- Free health services for all (irrespective of income, status or residence) in all State
 Government health care facilities starting from Sub centre, PHC, CHC, Area
 Hospital, SDH, District Health Quarter Hospital and all Govt. Medical College
 Hospitals and Blood Banks.
 - Further under this component, as mentioned above all health services are free of cost including free drugs, free diagnostics, free dialysis, free Cancer chemotherapy, free OT, free I.C.U., free in-patient admission etc., in all government health institutions up to all Govt. MCH, for all persons. For all cashless treatment no document is required.
- Additional facility of free healthcare beyond Government hospitals level in 192 empanelled Private Hospitals for families having BKKY card, BPL card or AAY card or annual income of Rs. 50,000/- in rural and Rs. 60,000/- in urban areas which cover over 70 lakh economically vulnerable families in the State are provided with Annual Health coverage of Rs. 5 lakh per family and Rs. 10 lakhs for the women members of the family. Patients having Cancer, Cardiac and Kidney related diseases can avail the above facilities even if their annual income is up to Rs. 3 lakhs. Even outside the State, all Govt. hospitals and premier health institutions are covered under BSKY.
